GEP3 Charleroi High School Scholarship

The GEP3 Scholarship Foundation was created in 2023 in remembrance of Charleroi Graduate, Glenn Porter (Class of 2021) by his family. They lost Glenn in a tragic automobile accident while on their way to vacation in Delaware. At the time of the accident, Glenn had just graduated from the IUP Police Academy and had accepted a full-time position with the California Borough Police Department in California, PA. He was eager to start his career in law enforcement following in the footsteps of many of his family members. His life dream was to positively impact his community while helping others-which is now the mission statement of the GEP3 Foundation. The foundation will help accomplish, through scholarships, this by investing in qualified individuals looking to achieve similar goals.

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded this year.

To be considered for the Glenn Edward Porter III Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a graduating senior from Charleroi Area High School
- Have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
 - *A high school transcript is required.*
- Have demonstrated leadership in extracurricular activities and/or athletics.
- Have demonstrated a commitment to their community.
- Plan to attend a post-secondary school or training program
 - *A letter of acceptance will be required.*
- Have demonstrated excellent work ethic, ability to overcome adversity, and/or has a positive impact someone in their everyday life.

*If other criteria listed are met, individuals who are/have been involved with a Charleroi High School Athletics Team for at least two seasons would receive preference.

Applications must be typed.
