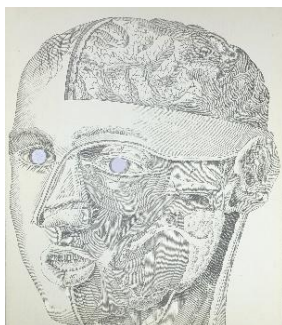

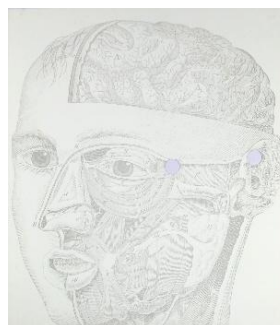

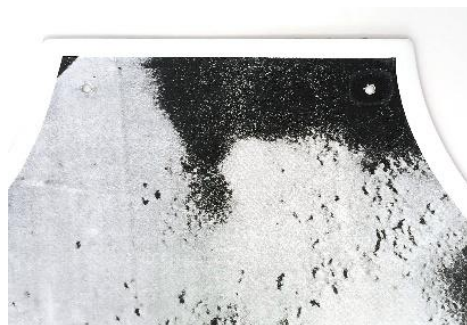

ReFlux Boxes

ReFlux Editions was founded by Barbara Moore in the early 1980's as a vehicle for continuing the publication of classic Fluxus multiples. Moore, owner of Bound and Unbound books in NYC, and a historian and cataloger of 1960-70s conceptual art and the Fluxus movement. From 1964 until his death in 1978 Moore was a friend and collaborator with George Maciunas. Most ReFlux Editions are collated from original, vintage, printed matter obtained directly from Maciunas or his estate, and the plastic-box containers may be vintage or were obtained from Maciunas' original source.

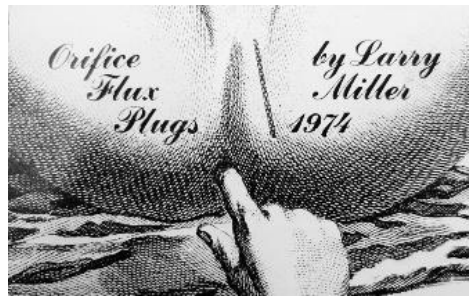

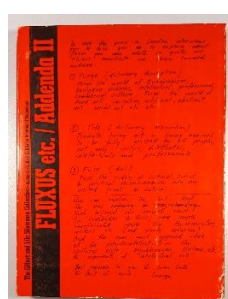

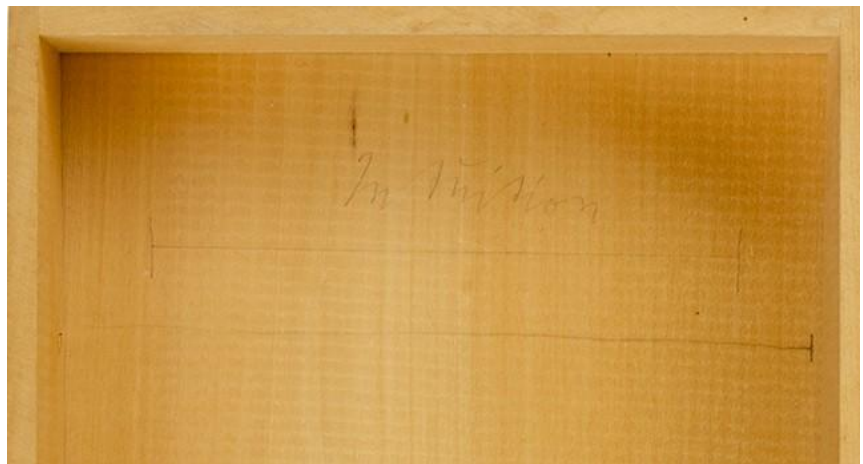

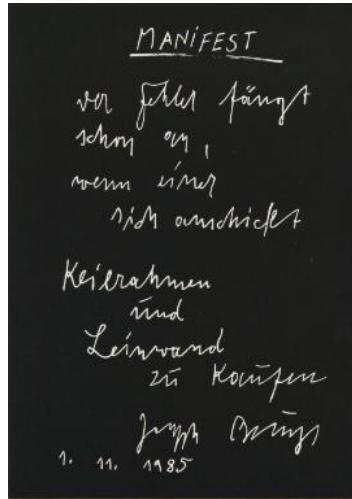
