

Lapp Princess Press – ISSUES 1 THROUGH 15

Lapp Princess Press LTD, New York City, 1977.

Set of 15 booklets published between 1977 – 1983. This set includes issues 1 through 15 (Missing volume 16, William Anastasi: *Content*)

Format 6x6 in / 15 x 15 cm, number of pages vary from publication to publication. Bindings include staplebound, some with gatefolds others are accordion books – Mangold book has a top-stitched binding. The Lapp Princess Press was founded in 1977 by writer and art critic Amy Baker. A total of sixteen booklets were published between 1977 and 1983. Each is a bookwork by an artist(s) commissioned by Lapp Princess Press. The books were printed in editions of 2,000 for wide inexpensive distribution.
