An electrocardiogram (EKG) technician is an allied healthcare professional responsible for operating specialized equipment to record the heart's electrical activity. This data is utilized by physicians and other medical professionals to diagnose and manage patients' cardiac conditions. It's an excellent entry point for those wishing to jumpstart their healthcare careers.

Eligibility Criteria for Becoming an EKG Technician:

1. Have an interest in patient care but prefer not to perform injections or blood drawing. Be able to obtain a certification that includes the necessary knowledge and skills for working with EKGs (electrocardiograms).
2. Successfully completed high school education or obtained a General Educational Development (GED) certificate or its equivalent.
3. Be at least 18 years old and capable of passing a background check and drug screening.
4. Complete an EKG training program to prepare for the certification exam

Alternate Titles for EKG Technicians

Depending on their work environment, the equipment they operate, and their training, EKG Technicians may be referred to by various titles, including Cardiac Monitor Technician, Cardiographic Technician, Rhythm Analysis Technician, or Telemetry Monitor Technician.
