FROM BISHOP MICHAEL LANGRISH

I am very much looking forward to my five weeks with you and hopefully to meeting you all during that time.

In 2013 I retired having been Bishop of Exeter for 14 years. Prior to that I had a ministry in parishes and education, was a Canon of Coventry Cathedral and Bishop of Birkenhead. Since retirement I have acted as an Assistant Bishop in the Dioceses of Chichester and Europe. It has been a particular privilege to work alongside several parishes and chaplaincies as they have gone through a period of uncertainty or difficulty, helping them to plan with confidence for their future. It is for this reason that Bishop Robert has asked me to carry out this visit on his behalf.

To plan for the future, it is necessary to understand the present, and understanding in my experience comes from speaking honestly and listening carefully. I will be discussing with the Wardens and Council how best this might be achieved.
