Dear Friends,

At Christmas we celebrate the astonishing truth that God has stepped into our world in the vulnerability of a child. In Jesus, hope is no longer an abstract idea or a distant promise. Hope has become flesh and blood. It is God drawing close to us, sharing our humanity so completely that no corner of our lives is untouched by His presence. The Christ child reminds us that God's answer to a troubled and weary world is not force or fear, but tenderness, mercy, and a love that chooses to walk beside us.

This year, perhaps more than ever, we sense how deeply we need that hope. Many of us are carrying concerns for our families, our health, our work, and the state of the world around us. We are searching for peace amid uncertainty, for healing in places of hurt, and for the strength to remain steady when life feels overwhelming. The message of Christmas speaks directly into this longing. The light born in Bethlehem is not a distant or theoretical light—it is a light that shines into real homes, real anxieties, and real wounds, offering calm, courage, and renewal.

And this same Christ, who came once in great humility, continues to come to us now. He is constantly knocking at the door of our hearts, inviting us to welcome Him more fully into our lives. Do not ignore that gentle knock. Do not be afraid to open the door. For only in His presence, and only by walking in His will, do our hearts find the rest and peace they truly seek.

May Giancarlo rest in eternal peace and rise in the Glory and Light of God's Holy Presence


