Dear beloved community of St. Edward's Church,

After concluding the Easter season with the glorious feast of Pentecost, we find ourselves ushered into a period of profound reflection and celebration within the liturgical calendar.

Right after Pentecost, the Church commemorates two significant feast days: Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi. On Trinity Sunday, we joyfully honour Our Triune God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - celebrating the mystery of God's eternal nature as three persons in one divine essence. We contemplate the depths of God's love revealed to us in this divine mystery.



But what is Corpus Christi? This solemnity, falling on June 2nd this year, holds a special place in our hearts as Anglicans. Corpus Christi, meaning "Body of Christ" in Latin, commemorates the institution of the Holy Eucharist, where Jesus offered His body and blood to His disciples at the Last Supper.

Dating back to the 13th century, this feast emerged as a way to honour the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and to express gratitude for the gift of His body and blood as spiritual sustenance for our journey of faith. It serves as a beautiful reminder of the central role the Eucharist plays in our worship and spiritual lives.

For us as Anglicans, the Feast of Corpus Christi holds particular significance. Rooted in our liturgical heritage, it reaffirms our belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the sacrament of the Eucharist. Just as Jesus shared Himself with His disciples, He continues to offer Himself to us in the bread and wine of the Eucharist, uniting us with Him and with one another in a profound communion of love.

This feast invites us to renew our love and devotion for the Eucharist, recognizing it as the source and summit of our Christian life. Each Sunday, as we gather to partake in the Eucharistic feast, we are invited to encounter the living Christ, who nourishes us with His body and blood, strengthens our faith, and sustains us on our journey of discipleship.

As we celebrate Corpus Christi, let us recommit ourselves to regular participation in the Eucharist on Sundays, recognizing it as the heart of our worship and the source of our spiritual nourishment. May this feast deepen our appreciation for the gift of Christ's presence among us and inspire us to live as faithful disciples, sharing His love and grace with all whom we encounter.


We are thrilled to announce a significant enhancement to our Sunday offering process: the introduction of a brand new payment system called Payaz!
