## ADVENT READING: JOY

**Leaders:** Advent is a word that means "coming" or "visit," and in the season of Advent, we focus our hearts and minds on the "Advent" of Christ.

This morning, as we move towards Christmas and the birth of Christ, Holy God made flesh, we continue to light the Advent candles in anticipation of celebrating Christ's birth and of the day when He will return in glory and bring His ultimate, everlasting joy for all eternity.

Today we relight the candles of Hope and Peace and light the candle of Joy.

As we do, we remember:

We remember that Christ alone is our ultimate source of Hope, Peace, and unimaginable and everlasting Joy. We remember God's promise to Israel of a messiah who will judge evil, make sorrow and sadness cease, and bring His everlasting joy forever.

We remember that rather than finding our joy in the abundance of material possessions, we are to find our true joy in Christ, the image of the invisible God made visible.

We remember that as we look back on the birth of our savior, look forward to His glorious return, and press forward in a world marred by sorrow and sadness, we can do so with confidence knowing that in Christ, we have a source of incomparable joy.

Light two purple candles, and one pink candle

turn over

**Unison Congregational Reading:** I will turn their mourning into joy; I will comfort them, and give them gladness for sorrow. Then shall the trees of the forest sing for joy before the Lord, for He comes to judge the earth.

**Leaders:** I will rejoice in the LORD; I will take joy in the God of my salvation. GOD, the Lord, is my strength; He makes my feet like the deer's; He makes me tread on my high places.

**Unison Congregational Reading:** Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice! Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand. When the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.

Leaders: Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.

Unison Prayer: Holy God, who announced your news of great joy for all people to lowly shepherds, as we light these candles this Advent season, we rejoice. We rejoice because we know that the first act of the story ended with the birth of Jesus the Messiah, and we rejoice because we know that the second act will end when He comes again in glory. Fix our hearts and minds on those things you have done and will do, and at all times, fill us with your joy as we hope in our savior, who has come and will come again! Amen!
