Blue's News

Summertime, summertime, sum-summertime, summertime whoa-a-oh-ah! These are the words of a 1958 hit song *Summertime* exploiting the joys of summer for a teenager. Lighter and peppier than *Alice Cooper's School's Out for Summer* I think of the song each year when summertime is near! What does this mean for our churches?

Church Planning—Carpe Diem! Seize the Day! Easter Sunday was a great day and pleasant surprise for most of our churches. The church planning/organization part of my brain went into gear the next day. Churches are having to react to regathering our congregations in the same way we reacted to the scattering of our people last year. We have been in a time of uncertainty. Now, restrictions somewhat are being lifted providing the church with opportunities to begin ministry again.

As related to church planning, this summer's activities should be planned, organized, and ready to run. If not, it is not too late, but work must begin now. Do not stop with summer planning. Planning for later this year should be in gear along with planning for 2022. Here are some things we should be thinking about as summer approaches:

- *VBS, Youth, and Children's Camps* should be organized and ready to go. These can still happen but will require quick planning and work. Talk to Robbie Isom, your ELBA Children's Team Leader if you need help in organizing.
- *Camp Living Waters* is receiving registrations for Children's Camps this summer. Consider our own camp for your summer children's camp.
- Determining ministries and related activities for the fall should be in the planning stage and ready to launch by mid summer. This would include D-Now, FORGE, Back-to-School, Fall Revivals, Harvest Festival/Trunk or Treat outreaches. Hey, I also hear Christmas bells ringing in this phase of planning. What will your church do to make the most of Christmas this year? Christmas is now the best time to reach first time church attenders.
- Organize for Sunday School and small groups now, but also consider how your church ministries and organizations will function this fall. Who will lead them? What training will you need to help your ministries to be successful? Hence, Nominating Committee work should begin soon after June 1st to meet August or September deadlines to begin the New Church Year.

Belarus Mission leader Andrew Rhyzkov is leading a group of Louisiana and Georgia Baptists to Belarus this September. ELBA has been asked to provide funding to print 2,000 copies of *Good and Evil: The Ultimate Comic Book Action Bible*. While bibles are illegal in Belarus, an illustrated comic book with bible stories is allowed. It costs \$10 per book to be printed in Belarus. I am asking our churches, Sunday School classes, small groups, and organizations to help us meet this goal by August 1st. Consider this challenge as a VBS offering goal this summer. Something happens to people when the Word of God is placed into their hands. Consider joining the trip to Belarus for service and ministry projects this fall.

Rumblin' for a Cause: Len Hodges' family needs help in producing a car show to benefit Camp Living Waters. If you, or your church is interested in helping with this cause, see Len's announcement in this newsletter.

IMB: The IMB has assigning to our missionaries a group of stateside churches to contact and build relationships committing to pray for the stateside churches and pastors as well as providing information so our churches will know how to pray for our missionaries and participate with them directly. Expect to hear from your missionaries beginning in May.

Southern Baptist Convention: Much has been said in the past two years about the SBC. The June 14-16 meeting has been moved to the Music City Center to provide a larger meeting venue. I plan to attend as are many pastors and church members in our association. It is not too late to register, but hotel rooms are filling fast. Pray for the SBC, our own LBC, and association in these days.







National Day of Prayer
