Happy New Year!!!

I consider it an honor to serve our association of churches as we close out 2022 and look with hope into 2023. I pray that you have enjoyed a blessed Christmas holiday and ready to march into the work of our Lord in the New Year. Here are a couple of things you may find helpful as we begin cooperatively in 2023:

Connect1Child Foster Care and Adoption Ministry: In cooperation with the Louisiana Baptist Children's Home we are launching this ministry and our Christian Social Services Ministry Team will lead in promoting this opportunity. Its purpose is to engage our churches with supporting Foster Care in our association. Work is underway and a coordinator will begin contacting churches soon.

Church Strengthening Team: I am asking our association to develop a Church Strengthening Team. There is a need to come alongside to help struggling churches. This may include a walk-beside partner or help the church to enter mission-status under the direction of a stronger church, which will help the church define and rediscover their Great Commission objective. This work will require cooperation, perseverance, money, effort, and much, much prayer.

Send Relief Mission Trip: A mission trip aimed at college, young adult, and possibly, graduated seniors is in the works.

Ray McCon, Family Life Minister at Walker Baptist Church, is organizing a Mission Trip through "NAMB Send Relief". An informational meeting will be held for all interested churches or individuals at Walker Baptist Church, Sunday, January 8, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. Please plan to attend or send someone in your place. This will be the first associational mission trip in a few years.

Dates: June 17-23, 2023 (seven-day trip)

Location: Send Relief NAMB Ministry Center, Memphis TN **Age:** College and Young Adult age, possibly Graduated Seniors

Cost: \$210 + travel + lodging - we will possibly be able to stay at a local church "world changer" style to save money

Expected Ministry Action: Cleaning out homes damaged by water and flood, prepare for community rebuilding, and community outreach.
