We have many hard months ahead to recover from the weight of this year. We can focus on the difficulties or rejoice in the blessings of God for which we should be thankful

**Thanksgiving** is a time for reflection on the greatness and glory of our God. We reflect on the blessings and bounty God has given us as a nation. We reflect on the great salvation for our sin provided by God to us through the completed work of Jesus' death and resurrection. We reflect on His abiding presence in the believer's life by the presence of His Holy Spirit. I have much for which to be thankful. How about you?

For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him. He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything. For it was the Father's good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him, and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him, I say, whether things on earth or things in heaven. And although you were formerly alienated and hostile in mind, engaged in evil deeds, yet He has now reconciled you in His fleshly body through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach....

**Thanksgiving!** A time to reflect and remember all that God has done for us, and for all He has given us. *In everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus* (1 Thess. 5:18 HCSB).
