Thank you, Dr. David Lane, for serving two years as our Moderator. Thank you, Dr. Larry Hubbard, for serving as our Vice-Moderator for the past two years and welcome as our Moderator moving forward. Our reports emphasized our motto, Together We Do What We Cannot Do Alone. Thank you to Rev. Paul Taylor, Bro. Jason Dyess, and the entire Pine Grove Baptist family for hosting our annual meeting and to your people for the delicious meal.

Pastor Appreciation has slipped under the radar this year due to Hurricane Ida. Our pastors (and staff) do not serve to earn the praise of others, but a word or act of encouragement will renew their heart and strength. If you missed the opportunity to express appreciation for your pastor and ministers, let them know how much you appreciate them.

**Covid-19?** The number of Covid-19 cases dropped below 650 for the first time since July 7<sup>th</sup>. The pandemic is not over. We still need to use best practices to limit the spread. Never feel safe enough to be careless is a good rule of thumb for now.

Disaster Relief will be wrapping up most of its jobs in the coming days. Here is the run-down on our churches after the storm. Eight churches received moderate to major damage requiring repair or a rebuild. Churches Helping Churches through the Louisiana Baptist Convention are aligning partner churches from other areas who desire to help our most damaged churches. ELBA 2022: There is a synergy when we do things together. We network, pray, encourage, help, cooperate, and engage our culture and world for Christ. Our Moderator and Vice-Moderator, Larry Hubbard and Dana Trahan have met and are planning some cooperative activities for the coming year. Stay tuned for more information.

Question: Do we want to continue the Latino Ministry? The Latino Ministry partnership with New Bethlehem, ELBA, the Latino congregation, and LBC is in its third year. This ministry is a bare bones ministry from a financial position. The Covid-19 Pandemic hit just as the ministry was gaining traction. We are now in the third year of the commitment. The LBC mission stipend provides \$18,000 annually to this effort, which is half of the financial support for the ministry. The LBC support will end after June 2022. This will be a \$9,000 shortfall in receipts for the ministry for the remainder of 2022 and the association will have a decision to make on funding 2023. Latino pastor Miguel Flores believes that the ministry is gaining traction once again. I am asking our churches to consider a special offering or to include the Latino Ministry in your budget for 2022 to offset this loss.

## Christian Counseling Center Seminar "Surviving the Holidays"




