The biblical concept of hope is a firm expectation of what God wants to accomplish in our lives and churches. Hope looks forward with a sense of purpose and possibility based upon the ways, purpose, and power of God. Hope is not just wishful thinking. Hope is seeing and hearing where God is working and then joining Him in what He is doing. Hope is grounded in faith—a trust that God can bring about His will and ways along with a conviction that God can accomplish His will, and ways.
