- Women 18 years of age or older
- Education (options)
 - High school graduate, or
 - HS equivalency completed, or
 - Currently enrolled in adult ed.
- Have transportation
- Alcohol and drug free for at least 6 months (for those in recovery)
- Fully committed to learn, grow and complete ALL coursework

Adult women of any race, religion or socio-economic status may apply.
Only those who meet admission requirements may enroll in CWJC as a student/ participant.

Potential students do NOT have to be a Christian to apply, to participate in training or to graduate; however, Bible study is required.

Enrollment is limited by space and instructor/volunteers available.

Volunteers may attend educational sessions as space allows.
