Credit card statements were provided from Town Clerk Jones, Public Works Director Bullard, and Mayor Pro Temp Baxley.

c. Water Department Usage and Savings

Mayor Spell explained that since Sampson County's new water tower has been built, it has caused the town's water tower to overfill due to elevation. Mayor Spell has ordered Public Works Director Bullard to turn off the water tower to prevent further water loss, which can cause problems with fire suppression, dirty water, and low water pressure. McGill Engineering and Chris Medlin recommend that an altitude valve and further communication equipment be installed. Commissioner Honeycutt emphasized that this is a problem caused by the county and should be the county's financial obligation. The board authorized Mayor Spell to work with the county to come up with a solution and present it to the board. They decided to take no action on Task Order #3 from McGill Engineering. County Commissioner Chip Crumpler and County Manager Alan Vann, who were present at the meeting, were invited to speak by the mayor and they indicated an eagerness to work with the town to find a solution.

d. LGC Withholding Sales Tax

The Local Government Commission has withheld a portion of the sales tax to Autryville pending completion of the missing audits. Town Clerk Jones said the 2023 audit had been submitted by the auditor last Friday.

#### 5. GRANT REPORT

Barnhill Construction started working on the retention pond last week and bringing pipes and materials for construction to begin.

b. Minnie Hall Road Water Line Extension

Project is pending per increased funding.

c. Street Improvement Grant

d. NCORR Grant for Local Government Services

The deadline for the grant is Spring 2026. Town Clerk Jones asked the board to bring ideas to the next board meeting to use the remaining funds.
