



HART COUNTY FISCAL COURT  
ELECTIONEERING ON ELECTION DAY

SECTION ONE. That the resolution passed by the Fiscal Court on September 20, 1977, Book 8, Page 157, allowing "electioneering" on election day be resended and that the County revert to state law (KRS 117.235(3)) which allows no "electioneering" on election day unless approved by Fiscal Court. KRS 117.235 states: No person shall do any electioneering at the polling place on election day... "Electioneering" shall include the displaying of signs, the distribution of campaign literature, cards or handbills, the soliciting of signatures to any petition, or question on the ballot in any manner.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon passage and publication.
