

Hart County Ordinance Number 220.12 B

ORDINANCE BY THE COUNTY OF HART AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER KOC 220.12 ESTABLISHING THE HART COUNTY TOURISM COMMISSION AND IMPOSING A THREE (3 %) TRANSIENT ROOM TAX

WHEREAS, the Hart Fiscal Court established the Hart County Tourism Commission pursuant to the provisions of KRS 91A.350 (2) for the purpose of promoting tourism activity and imposed a three (3%) transient room tax by Ordinance Number KOC 220.12; and


WHEREAS, the Hart Fiscal Court recommends deleting that portion of paragraph eight (8) of said Ordinance which states that "[a]t least 85% of the monies collected shall be used for direct media purchase";

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF HART COUNTY, KENTUCKY, THAT paragraph eight (8) of KOC 220.12 is hereby amended to henceforth read as follows:

The commission shall elect from its membership a chairman and a treasurer, and may employ such personnel and make such contracts as are necessary to carry out the purpose of KRS 91A.350 to 91A.390, or as amended. The contracts may include, but shall not be limited to, the procurement of promotional services, advertising services, and other services and materials relating to the promotion of tourist and convention business. Contracts of the type enumerated shall be made only with persons, organizations, and firms with experience and qualifications for providing promotional services and materials, such as advertising firms, chambers of commerce, publishers, and printers.

All remaining sections of KOC 220.12 shall remain unchanged hereby and remain in full force and effect.
