HART COUNTY FISCAL COURT

ORDINANCE # 220.30

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 68.005, the Fiscal Court shall adopt a county administrative code, which includes, but is not limited to, procedures and designation of responsibility for:

- (a) General administration of the office of county judge/executive, county administrative agencies, and public authorities;
- (b) Administration of county fiscal affairs, including budget formulation, receipt and disbursement of county funds and preparation of records required for the county audit, and the filing of claims against the county;
- (c) Personnel administration, including description and classification of nonelected positions, selection, assignment, supervision and discipline of employees, employee complaints and the county affirmative action program;
- (d) County purchasing and award of contracts;
- (e) Delivery of county services.

AND WHEREAS, the Hart Fiscal Court has prepared an administrative code dated June 11, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF HART COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

1). That the administrative code consisting of (80) pages, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, is hereby adopted at its first reading on this date and shall be duly published for its second reading.

2). The administrative code shall be recorded by the county clerk in the order book of the Fiscal Court of Hart County, Kentucky.
