AMENDING SECTION OF THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

KOC 620.26

AN ORDINANCE Relating to the County Road System and Amendment Thereof.

WHEREAS, the Hart County Fiscal Court established a formal road system by county ordinances KOC 620.1 through 620.25; and

WHEREAS, KOC 620.4 established that in order to be adopted into the system a road must serve a public purpose. In order to serve a public purpose or purposes it shall meet three (3) of the five (5) following qualifications:


- a) Have three (3) occupied houses per mile.
- b) Be a mail route.
- c) Be a mile route.
- d) Be a school bus route.
- e) Serve as a farm to market road for cash crops.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF HART COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, THAT:

In addition to the preceding five qualifications the following sixth qualification be added:


- f) Have at least one (1) licensed business.
