AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PARKS,
PLAYGROUNDS AND RECREATION BOARD
IN HART COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hart County that:

SECTION I. There is hereby created a Parks, Playgrounds and Recreation Board to the provisions and procedures of KRS 97.010 to 97.050 and KRS 67.083 (3) which shall include the total area within the borders of Hart County, Kentucky and shall be called the "Hart County Parks, Playgrounds and Recreation District.

SECTION II. The Hart County Parks, Playgrounds and Recreation District shall be a continuing public entity and exist until such as is dissolved or terminated by duly enacted ordinance by the Fiscal Court of Hart County.


SECTION III. The Hart County Parks, Playgrounds and Recreation District shall be managed and operated by a Board of Directors to be appointed by the Hart County Judge/Executive and confirmed by Hart County Fiscal Court. The Board shall consist of five members to serve for terms of four (4) years and until their successors are appointed, except that the members first appointed shall be one (1) for one (1) year, one (1) for two (2) years, one (1) for three (3) years and two (2) for four (4) years. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments and for the unexpired term. The Board shall elect a Chairman, Secretary, and Treasurer and shall operate under a budget and uniform accounting system as required by law, including the filing and publishing of annual statements.

SECTION IV. Hart County Parks, Playgrounds and Recreation District shall have the power to provide, conduct and maintain parks, playgrounds and recreation centers as specified in KRS 97.030.

SECTION V. The Hart County Parks, Playgrounds and Recreation District shall submit a regular and annual budget report to be approved by the Hart County Fiscal Court.

SECTION VI. Hart County Parks, Playgrounds and Recreation District shall have the power to adopt rules and regulations to comply with local and state laws, as approved by Fiscal Court.
