OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TAX

COUNTY OF HART ORDINANCE NO. 220.14A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HART COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 220.14 RELATING TO THE IMPOSITION AND ADMINISTRATION OF AN OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE REQUIREMENT, AND PAYMENT OF AN OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TAX BY PERSONS AND BUSINESS ENTITIES CONDUCTING BUSINESSES, OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS WITHIN HART COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the Hart County Fiscal Court established an Ordinance imposing occupational license taxes on persons and business entities conducting businesses, occupations, and professions within Hart County, so that the assessment and payment of Occupational License Taxes can be administered more efficiently.

WHEREAS, the Hart Fiscal Court recommends amending Section 3(5) and omitting Section 3(6)(i) of said ordinance;

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Hart County Fiscal Court that Section 3(5) of Ordinance No. 220.14 is hereby amended to henceforth read as follows:

§ 3 - Occupational License Tax Payment Required

(5) The maximum amount to be collected from any business, corporation or individual in one year shall be set at Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars. Any business, corporation or individual electing to pay this maximum amount shall do so by the fifteenth (15th) day of the fourth (4th) month following the close of each year.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Hart County Fiscal Court that Section 3(6)(i) of Ordinance No. 220.14 shall henceforth be omitted.

All remaining sections of Ordinance No. 220.14 shall remain unchanged hereby and remain in full force and effect.
