

FIRE DETECTION DEVICES ORDINANCE

KOC 340.1

AN ORDINANCE Relating to the Installation of Fire Detection Devices.

WHEREAS, public safety is a responsibility of Hart Fiscal Court; and

WHEREAS, protection of the citizens of Hart County from the dangers of fire to person and property is a major consideration; and

WHEREAS, the proper installation and maintenance of smoke and/or fire detection systems have proven to be successful in the early detection of fires and thereby reduce the loss of life and property damage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF HART, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. An ordinance be passed that requires the installation of fire and/or smoke detection devices in all dwellings, manufacturing facilities, places of public business, places of public assembly and mobile homes to be constructed or moved into the boundaries of Hart County from the date of the passage of this ordinance.

Section 2. Such detection devices shall be of the type that operate on normal house current. Such devices shall be approved by Underwriters Laboratory.

Section 3. A minimum of one (1) such device shall be located on each level of a structure and two (2) on the main occupied level.

Section 4. Compliance to be insured by inspection of the Hart County Building Inspector.
