ORDINANCE NUMBER: 2012- 440-5A

Hart County Fiscal Court adopted Ordinance # 440-5A on the regular meeting August 2, 2012,.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCE # 440-5:

WHEREAS, synthetic drugs have posed a danger to Hart County citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Hart County Fiscal Court took action to limit the sale of synthetic drugs by the passage of Ordinance #:440-5 as there was no Kentucky statute regulating the sale of synthetic drugs; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 Kentucky General Assembly passed House Bill 481 regulating synthetic drugs; and

WHEREAS, 2012 Kentucky General Assembly House Bill 481 supersedes Hart County Ordinance #:440-5, it is necessary to repeal Hart County Ordinance # 440-5

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF HART, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE


Hart County Ordinance # 440-5 is hereby repealed.
