SUMMARY

A regulation requiring the disposal of Hart County's solid waste (excluding composted or recycled items) in the Glasgow City Landfill.


WHEREAS, Chapter 224 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes requires Hart County to provide for the long term disposal needs of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Glasgow and Hart County have entered into a ten (10) year agreement effective July 1, 1992 which requires that all of the county's solid waste, excluding composted and recycled items be disposed of at the landfill;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE HART COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT, pursuant to Chapter 109.59 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes as follows:

Effective July 1, 1992 all solid waste generated in Hart County, Kentucky, excluding composted and recycled items, shall be disposed of at the Glasgow City Landfill.

Approved by the Hart County Solid Waste Management District on the 10th day of June, 1992.



FIRST READING CONDUCTED THE 10th DAY OF JUNE, 1992.


SECOND READING CODUCTED THE 24th DAY OF JUNE, 1992.
