We were blessed to have **Bro. John Burnham and his wife from the Gideons**. Bro. Burnham gave a report on his work and




shared very powerful real-life situations of how lives were changed as result of their Bible

Airplane Mode

If you have a smartphone, you're probably aware of the convenient feature called, "Airplane Mode". In its essence, we find that airplane mode is often used to manually disconnect your cell phone from its data functions. It was originally created with the purpose of avoiding any interference with sensors, signals, and equipment used to operate aircrafts. While your phone is on airplane mode, you will not receive phone calls, texts, or any notifications. This may seem extremely inconvenient for someone who is awaiting a call or email, but airplane mode also has the ability to extend battery life, and will even charge faster when in contact with a power source. As Christians, we can find ourselves in spiritual airplane mode. We might feel disconnected, isolated, or unsatisfied with our connection to the Lord. Timothy 2:3-4 says, "Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of [this] life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a good soldier." The word 'endure' in Hebrew means to "bear up under". When I read that definition, my mind automatically went to Psalm 91:4 that says, "He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler." No matter the situation, we are instructed to endure through the hardness as that of a good soldier. A good soldier trusts his sergeants, obeys his commands, and doesn't question his direction. That doesn't mean we are always going to "feel connected", but the Bible says He's as close as the mention of His name. That's truth! It means we know who our power source is. We can bear up under our Master and trust His word to be absolute truth, because his record is flawless. You may not always see evidence of His provision, but He is working nonetheless. In fact, it's usually the silence that allows us to hear Him more clearly, and gives us the opportunity to fall deeper in love with our Savior. He will recharge your heart far greater than any tangible thing ever will or possibly could. Surrendering all of you can feel like you're living in airplane mode, because it requires you to submit your flesh to Him fully. It might be uncomfortable, lonely, and quiet, but He is and will forever be an ever present help. Jesus Himself knew that without a refilling of his presence our spiritual batteries would drain and eventually die, but Galatians 6:9 says, "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not." When your spiritual battery is draining, don't wait for Him, put yourself on airplane mode and get in His presence, that's your most effective power source.



To the Saints of the Emmanuel Holiness Conference that I have not yet met, I am Sister Gail Peters, wife of evangelist L.W. Peters. Thank you for endorsing my husband in the Office of Evangelist to carry the great gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I would like to share a thought in scripture with our readers today. If you have been a Christian very long, you have experienced a few seasons of weariness. Life is not always filled with mountain top moments. This is also true of our walk with God. Sometimes we walk thru dry places where we wonder where God is and yearn for the strength to carry on. We have all just come through a worldwide pandemic that brought about many changes in our lives and in our world. These hardships and trials can lead to weariness. We don't know the exact details of the book of Hebrews, but we can all agree that the audience of Hebrews were Jewish Christians in Rome anticipating severe persecution and hardship. In their weariness, they were tempted to turn away from Jesus and return to the safety of Judaism that they had always known. The writer of this great book wanted to encourage them and keep them from drifting away from their faith in Jesus. Sometimes trials push us towards Jesus, and other times they have the effect of leading us away from him. You may not be tempted to abandon your faith, but perhaps you are praying less, reading less, and spending less time among other believers. You are weary. My encouragement to you is to keep holding on to Jesus because He is a Firm Foundation and a Solid Rock as you walk through this season. Hebrews says "since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." Jesus is not only our High Priest; He is our Great High Priest. This means that we can

always come to Him with our weaknesses and pain. He not only understands, but is also able to help us. We are often tempted to turn from God when we are weary. However, in weariness, we must draw near to Jesus who completely understands what it means to feel weak and has the power to strengthen and comfort us. When you come to God in your weariness, you will not experience God's judgment. God will not reject those who earnestly seek Him. Instead of judgment, you will receive God's mercy and grace. Keep holding on to Jesus. He is a sure foundation. When you are anchored in Christ, you can have security when you walk through hardship. Don't give up in this season. Persevere in faithfulness to Christ and hold on to His strong arms as He leads and guides you each day.



Praise God the devil is already defeated!


I don't have to worry and I don't have to flee from the enemy. I can rest safely in God Almighty's Refuge.

There is power in prayer and in the blood of Jesus!


