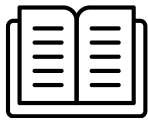

THURS-SAT

FRI

6/18--READ/LISTEN: PREPARE YOUR HEART FOR SUNDAY'S WORSHIP BY WATCHING ON YOUTUBE WITH THE LYRICS

- **8:15-- "Good Good Father"** Gods love for us is undeniable. How humbling to know He is so good & loves us so much.
- **9:30 & 11-- "Reckless Love"** Remember, God adores us, simply because we are His. We don't have to earn His love.

SAT

6/19--PRAY:

- Thank God for His unconditional love
- Ask Him to open your mind as you listen to His Word tomorrow
- Pray for the people serving & staff as they prepare for tomorrow's service & weekly events.

SUN

6/20--LISTEN & TAKE NOTES:

- What's a parable? What does this one say about the nature of God, us, & our relationship with others?

- What verse or phrase do you want to pray over or memorize? Write it out & post it where you will see it.

MON

6/21--READ OVER SCRIPTURE & SERMON NOTES

- What did the Shepherd do when his sheep was lost?
- What did the Shepherd do when he found the sheep?
- What happens when a shepherd returns to his home & flock after finding a lost sheep?
- How is Jesus the shepherd in our lives?

TUES

6/22--REFLECT:

- What causes God to rejoice most?
- In what ways do we go astray?
- What steps can you take to avoid going astray?
- How can you make a difference for someone else?

WED

6/23--PRAY

- Ask God to give you the heart of the shepherd & to show you your one.
- Confess to Him where you've strayed & pray for His guidance, wisdom, discernment, & strength.
