



Scripture Reflections for Worship Service

God's Vision Transforms Our Perspective: God sees the world and us through a lens of boundless creativity and possibility, inviting us to align our perspective with His to discover new opportunities for growth and purpose.

Below are selected verses that reflect the worship theme, "God's Vision Transforms Our Perspective," paired with reflective questions to encourage personal application of God's creative and transformative perspective.

1. Isaiah 55:8-9 (NIV)

"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the Lord. "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."

• **Reflective Question**: How might embracing God's higher perspective open your eyes to new possibilities in a situation where you feel stuck?

2. 1 Samuel 16:7 (NIV)

"But the Lord said to Samuel, 'Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."

• **Reflective Question**: Where in your life might God see potential or value that you or others have overlooked?

3. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIV)

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

• **Reflective Question**: How can seeing yourself as a new creation in Christ inspire you to pursue a fresh opportunity or purpose?

4. Romans 12:2 (NIV)

"Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will."

• **Reflective Question**: What is one area of your life where renewing your mind with God's perspective could lead to transformation?

5. Psalm 139:13-14 (NIV)

"For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well."

• **Reflective Question**: How does knowing you are fearfully and wonderfully made by God change the way you view your own potential?

6. Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

• **Reflective Question**: What hope or future opportunity might God be inviting you to see through His lens of possibility?
