Facing Opposition Nehemiah 4

Summary: Life throws curveballs—criticism, setbacks, or straight-up opposition. In Nehemiah 4, we see Nehemiah and his crew rebuilding Jerusalem's walls while facing mockery and threats from haters like Sanballat and Tobiah. Instead of folding, they leaned into prayer, stayed vigilant, and kept working. You're building something too—your home, your faith, your kids'/grandkids' future. Opposition is inevitable, but God's strength is invincible.

Application: Name It, Pray It, Do It

This week, take a moment to name one challenge you're facing. Maybe it's a strained relationship, a work stress, or just the chaos of parenting. Then, do two things:

- **Pray**: Ask God for strength, wisdom, and peace. Lay it all at His feet.
- Act: Take one practical step forward. Set a boundary, have that tough convo, or make a plan to tackle the issue.

For example: If you're stressed about parenting, pray for patience, then try a new routine—like a 10-minute family devotional or a no-screens night to connect with your kids.

Challenge: Share your challenge with a trusted friend or spouse and pray together. Then, check in next week—how'd it go?
