This will be an open workshop for you to work on a project of your own choosing. Lynne will help you to color plan and develop your project. She will have her beautiful dyed wools for sale for this project or the next. On Wednesday morning, July 3rd, Lynne's "store" will be available for others to come to Crippen Creek to purchase Lynne's hand dyed wools. You do not need to take the workshop to shop on Wednesday morning.

The workshop will take place at The Inn at Crippen Creek Farm in Skamokawa, WA. All lodging (shared rooms and baths), meals and instruction are included in the price of \$495.00. You can check out our facilities on our website.

She also loves helping people resurrect projects that need to come out of the closet!
