Certified teacher, Barb Powell, will teach a “fishy stitches” rug but you are welcome to try the stitches on whatever project you choose. at the Friends by the Sea rug camp in March. Also on board will be Roxanne Ross as our wool vendor. Roxanne is a certified McGown teacher and has been hooking for 9 years. Her specialty is making patterns and dyeing wool and yarn. She is coming from Idaho and we are so grateful as she has gorgeous wool and will have it for sale.

The “fishy stitches” pattern will be sent on paper to all participants before the workshop. You will be able to put it on whatever backing you choose and bring it ready to be worked on if that is the project you want to do. You can bring wool or buy it from Roxanne when you are here.

The workshop begins on Saturday, May 16th and ends on Tuesday morning, May 19th. Arrive on Saturday afternoon and get set up. Enjoy a gourmet dinner at the Inn and return to the Roadhouse for an evening of hooking and socializing. The class is limited to 7 so be sure to register early.
