TRANSPARENCY IN SUPPLY OF MODERN SLAVERY ACT POLICY

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INTRODUCTION

At Thriveology Wellness CIC, we are committed to ensuring transparency in our supply chain to help prevent modern slavery and human trafficking. We believe in conducting business ethically and responsibly, and we expect the same from our suppliers and partners.

6. Regularly review and update our policies and procedures to ensure compliance with the Transparency in Supply of Modern Slavery Act 2015.
