# Yearly Call-In Application

Participation in the "Yearly Call-In" program is optional. If you plan on competing in the same events and attending several rodeos, this program allows you to automatically be enrolled in events without calling in for each rodeo.

# Instructions:

- 1) Fill out the application completely (Please, write legibly.)
- Email a scanned copy or a picture of the completed application to <u>rodeo@say-rodeo.com</u>. Entitle the email "YEARLY CALL-IN for *name of applicant*".

# By completing this application:

- The applicant will be "automatically" added to the rodeo roster for each remaining rodeo, *except for Finals*, with the events indicated on the application. *You will still have to call in or email in for Finals*.
- 2) The applicant agrees to pay all rodeo fees either by our "par-payment" options or at the rodeo.
- 3) In order to "call out" or change events, the applicant agrees to either email or call in **prior** to the end of the call-in period for the rodeo at no charge, or during the "late" call-in period, when a late charge will apply. Changes include, but are not limited to, registering or removing events, changing IMRA or Jr NFR events, and changing entries for Side Jackpots. (If you know of dates now that would require a "call out", you may enter those dates on the application, and no email or call will be required for calling out of that specific rodeo.)
- 4) Junior/Senior Team Ropers: You will be enrolled with "draw" partners. If you have arranged for a specific partner, you will need to call-in with your partner.

# What you can expect:

- 1) Once the application is received and processed, you will receive a "Yearly Call-In Profile" email, which details the information on your application form. This email confirms your enrollment.
- Several days prior to each rodeo (except Finals), events will be automatically entered, and you will receive a "Rodeo Events and Fees" email. You can use that email as a reminder to let us know of any changes that might need to be made.

# **Event Restrictions:**

Per rules, the following restrictions apply:

- 1) Pee Wee Division: You may not compete in both Mutton Busting and Calf Riding.
- 2) Youth Division: You may not compete in Dummy Roping if competing in any other roping event
