

The room you stay in

We will try our best to give you the room you have requested. Rooms are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. However, sometimes the room you request may not be available due to medical or infection control needs.

If you stay in a room that is different from the type of room you requested, you will only be billed for the type of room you actually stay in:

Semi-Private or Private Room	Ward Room	No charge
Semi-Private Room	Semi-Private or Private Room	For a Semi-Private Room (\$325/day)
Private Room	Semi-Private Room	For a Semi-Private Room (\$325/day)
Private Room	Private Room	For a Private Room (\$475/day)

OHIP patients requesting ward rooms will not be charged no matter what room type they are placed in.

Please note: If you are admitted to the high risk unit a representative will visit you to discuss your room request. Billing for high risk units are separate from the process described in the billing chart.

Preferred Accommodation

If you stay as an inpatient at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre, you can request your preference from one of three types of patient rooms:

- **Ward (three or more beds in the room):**
Free of charge for OHIP patients
- **Semi-Private (two beds in the room):**
\$325 per day
- **Private (one bed in the room):**
\$475 per day

All OHIP-insured patients are provided with a ward room free of charge. Private and semi-private room accommodation **is optional** for patients who wish to have more privacy during their stay.

How to sign up for preferred accommodation



Complete the form at [sunnybrook.ca/ob-preferred-accommodation](https://www.sunnybrook.ca/ob-preferred-accommodation) any time prior to your hospital admission.

If you select a private or semi-private room accommodation preference, a \$0.10 **non-refundable** payment will be charged to your credit card to confirm your choice.

Applications completed without credit card payment of the \$0.10 deposit will not be considered.

Sunnybrook accepts Visa, Mastercard, Amex, Discover, Visa Debit and Mastercard debit.

If you don't have a credit card, please contact accommodation@sunnybrook.ca to arrange a pre-payment option.

Billing

You will be billed starting and including the day that you give birth to your baby regardless of the delivery time. All subsequent days you spend in the hospital will also be billed except for your date of discharge.

All patients are provided with a private room while they are in labour. Charges only begin once you have given birth to your baby.

Within one week of your discharge from hospital, the credit card provided during sign-up (the same one used for the \$0.10 non-refundable payment) will be automatically charged for the full amount of any outstanding preferred accommodation charges.

Sunnybrook no longer bills third party insurance companies for maternity patients. However, a detailed invoice and receipt containing all the information required to file your insurance claim will be emailed to you at the same time as your credit card payment is processed.

If you change your mind

If you previously signed up for ward accommodation, and have changed your mind, please visit [sunnybrook.ca/ob-preferred-accommodation](https://www.sunnybrook.ca/ob-preferred-accommodation) and complete a new form with your updated preference.

If you signed up for a semi-private or private room and would like to change your preference to a ward room, you must contact accommodation@sunnybrook.ca by email PRIOR to your hospital admission to update your preference.

Patients who do not provide notification in writing will be charged for their original choice.
