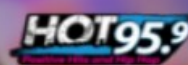

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO 6TH GRADE PARENTS**

Florida State Law requires that all students receive a Tdap immunization booster **BEFORE** entering into 7th grade. In addition to elementary grade vaccines, students entering or attending seventh grade need the following:

- One dose of tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap) vaccine
- An updated DH 680 form, to include Tdap, must be obtained for submission to the school
