AS YOU PREPARE FOR THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR...

Just a reminder of a few school policies as you prepare over the summer for the next school year.

UNIFORM PROVIDER: **DOTS** is located at 4424 S. Hopkins Ave. in Titusville. Phone # 321-567-3527.

ONLY TCS logo jackets, sweatshirts and sweaters may be worn to school. Jackets/sweatshirts can be ordered from DOTS, our uniform provider. Secondary students (7th-12th grade) may also wear their class designed jacket/sweatshirt. No caps, visors, hoods, hoodies, do-rags or sunglasses are to be worn in the building during school hours. Body markings of any kind including tattoos are not permitted. Students with existing markings will be required to keep them covered at all times. Piercings on any body parts other than an earlobe for girls, (including the face) are strictly forbidden.

Physical Education: Orders will be taken at Meet & Greet for TCS logo T-shirts and TCS knee length athletic shorts for students in **5th** and **6th grade, Team Sports** (secondary), and **athletes** to wear during sports practice. Tennis shoes are required. No sleeveless or cut-off t-shirts permitted.

Physicals and Immunizations: It is school policy that all students have an updated physical (within one year of school starting) on file. Incoming 6th grade students must have a scoliosis screening as part of the physical. Also, all incoming Kindergarten and 7th grade students must be current on immunizations prior to the start of school. Please contact your health provider to confirm your status.

Secondary Class Schedules: Our goal is for the secondary students to have their 2022-2023 class schedules by the end of this school year! Of course, schedules are subject to change.

School Supplies: Supply lists will be posted on the school website by mid-June.

Meet & Greet: Make plans to attend on **Thursday, August 4th**. Come any time between 9 am –1 pm or 4 pm-7pm. This is an opportunity to visit teachers in their classrooms; pick-up class schedules; collect important paperwork; sign-up for music lessons; receive sports info; and so much more!

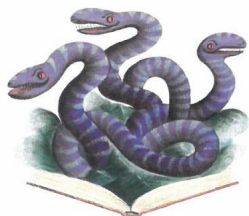
Reading Challenge Ages 5-12
