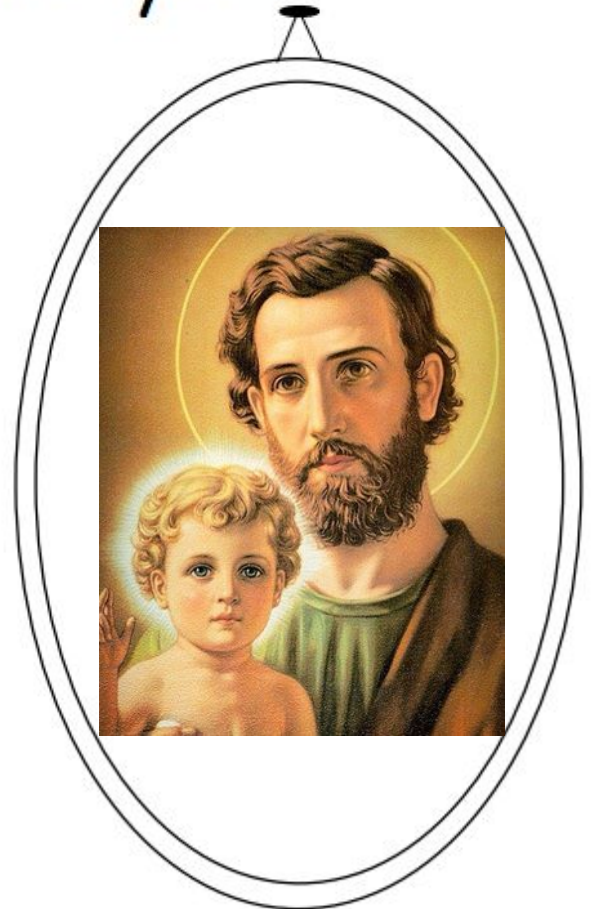


A Mini Biography of Saint Joseph

Feast Day	St. Joseph feast day is March 19.

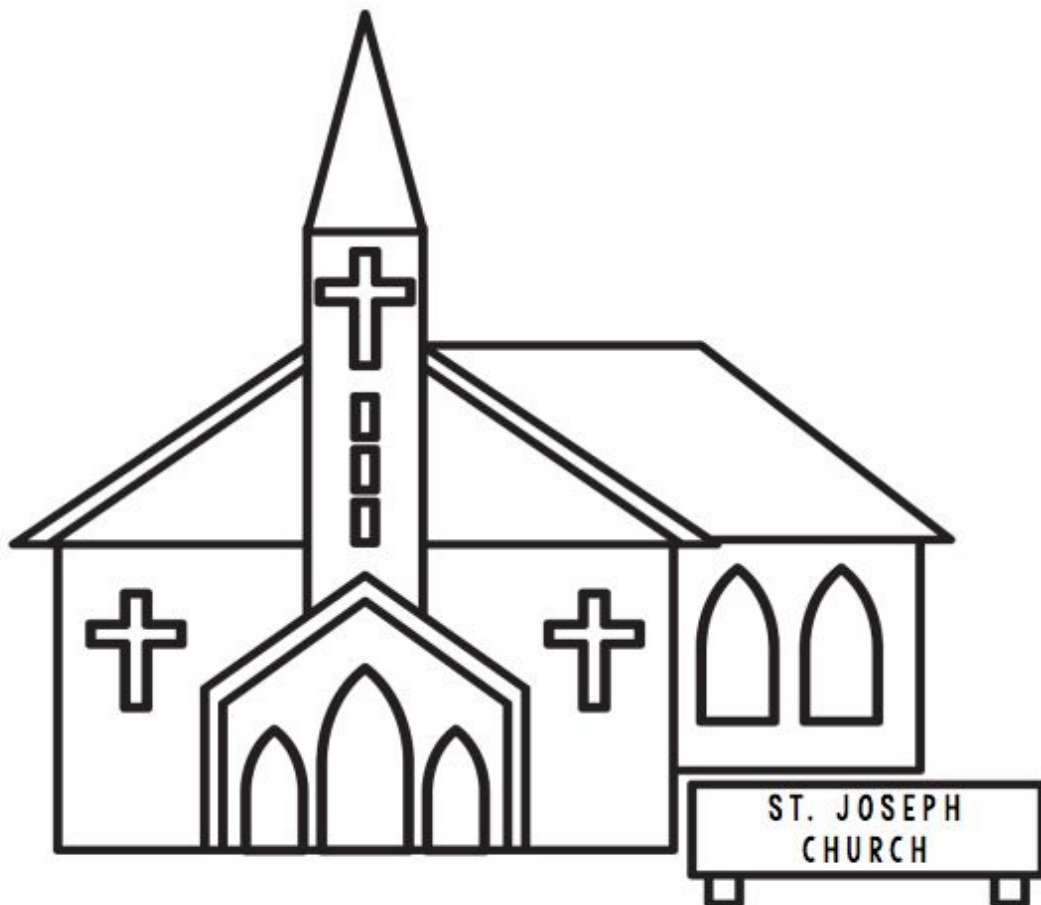
