



The Life of SAINT JOSEPH

Although the veneration of Joseph seems to have begun in Egypt, the earliest western devotion to him dates from the early 14th century, when the Servites, an order of mendicant friars, observed his feast on March 19, the traditional day of his death.

The circumstances of Joseph's death are unknown, except that he probably died before Jesus' public ministry began and was certainly dead before the Crucifixion. Some of the subsequent apocryphal narratives concerning Joseph are extravagantly fictitious.
