- **VNEA RULES** (including 8-Ball patching) **WILL BE USED FOR THIS EVENT.** Complete rules can be found at [www.vnea.com](http://www.vnea.com) and on-location.
- 15-minute match reporting requirement
- Rack your own – Alternating breaks
- No winning/losing on the break (no 8-ball break win)
- No personal videoing of matches allowed
- No practicing allowed on open tournament tables during event times. Tables may be designated as ‘practice’ tables later in each day and every morning before event starts.
- No coaching allowed
- Fargo Master players = >650 rating (with robustness)

- 15-minute match reporting requirement
- Flip for Home Team – Home Team completes team line-up first on scoresheet
- Original scoresheet will be official match score (both teams should verify game scores throughout the match)
- Rack your own – breaks pre-determined on scoresheet
- No winning/losing on the break (no 8-ball break win)
- No personal videoing of matches allowed
- No coaching allowed
- No practicing allowed on open tournament tables during event times. Tables may be designated as ‘practice’ tables later in each day and every morning before event starts.

## **TEAM EVENT RULES:**

- **VNEA RULES (including 8-ball patching) WILL BE USED FOR THIS EVENT.** Complete rules can be found at [www.vnea.com](http://www.vnea.com) and on-location.
- Teams must have at least THREE (3) original team members who are responsible to shoot every match round. All other rostered players must be from within the **same pool league**...not just the sanctioning body (i.e. APA, TAP, etc)
- VNEA rule match substitutions are allowed as long as the following criteria are met:
  1. Any team captain who MAY wish to substitute a player during the match **must let the opposing captain know their possible interest prior to match start.**
  2. If a substitution is to be made, that team captain must let the opposing team know of the substitution **prior to the first game being played in THAT round** (i.e. 'Joe' will be coming in for 'Bob' in this upcoming round).
  3. **No substitution (or re-substitution) may result in a player playing the same player on the other team twice.**
- 15-game format (5x3) – Open teams. \*16-game format (4x4) – Women's teams (*same as 2022*).
- Flip for 'Home' team (Home team completes score sheet first and keeps 'master' score sheet)
- Team captains and match players are responsible for having correctly matched players at each table.  
***\*Hint: Players should INTRODUCE themselves prior to a match to guarantee proper players.***
- Rack/Break your own – Breaks designated on score sheet
- No coaching allowed
- Match is won by TOTAL ACCUMULATED POINTS. Match is over when score deficit cannot be caught up in remaining games.
- 15-minute match reporting requirement
- No practicing on open tables during event times. Tables may be designated as 'practice' tables later in each day and every morning before event starts.

## **GENERAL WEST COAST CHALLENGE FLORIDA EVENT INFORMATION:**

- Player and team placements will be determined by the tournament Director based upon – Player's average(s)/skill level as supported by the provided statistics, Player's known ability, and/or input from League Coordinators and other Tournament Directors.  
***\*NOTE:*** We rely on player's honesty when providing all information – correct name, averages/skill level, league placement. Correct information is crucial in properly placing players and teams into divisions. Incorrectly reporting information to the tournament will result in immediate removal from the event with no refund of entry fees.
- Tournament events will all be using CompuSport software for matches. Please have this installed on your phones by the time of this event.
- Be certain of your plans before registering for this event as **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN ONCE ENTRY HAS BEEN RECEIVED.**

- Teams should consider additional players for your team roster in order to plan for unforeseen circumstances.
- Once the tournament event has begun, no match ‘holds’ can be allowed as this affects the flow of the tournament playing brackets.
- Dress Code: No sleeveless tops, no short shorts, no ‘flip flops’ (strapped on sandals are acceptable)
- 15-minute match reporting will be strictly enforced. Players SHOULD be present in main tournament room 30-minutes prior to their posted match time. Matches will be called out as tables are available.
- Slow play will be monitored closely with excessive match times possibly resulting in a timed end (vs. race end).
- Players must carry personal ID on them at all times.
- No smoking or **e-cigarettes** are allowed inside venue.
- You are not permitted to wear earphones of any type during tournament play. This includes ear buds, headphones, headsets, Bluetooth devices, etc. Hearing aids, of course, are allowed.
- No video-recording equipment (video cameras or phone cameras) is allowed during match play.
- Live-streaming will be done on specific ‘live-stream tables’ throughout the event.
- No outside food or beverages (or drink containers) are allowed in tournament rooms by players or spectators.
