Give Unity



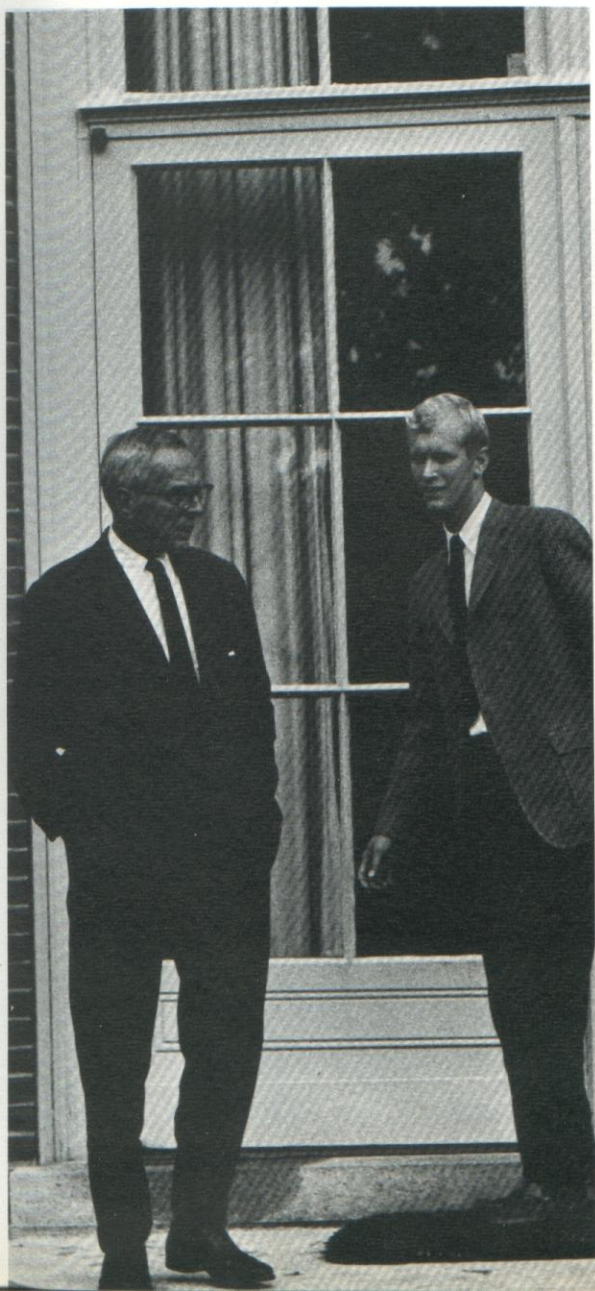

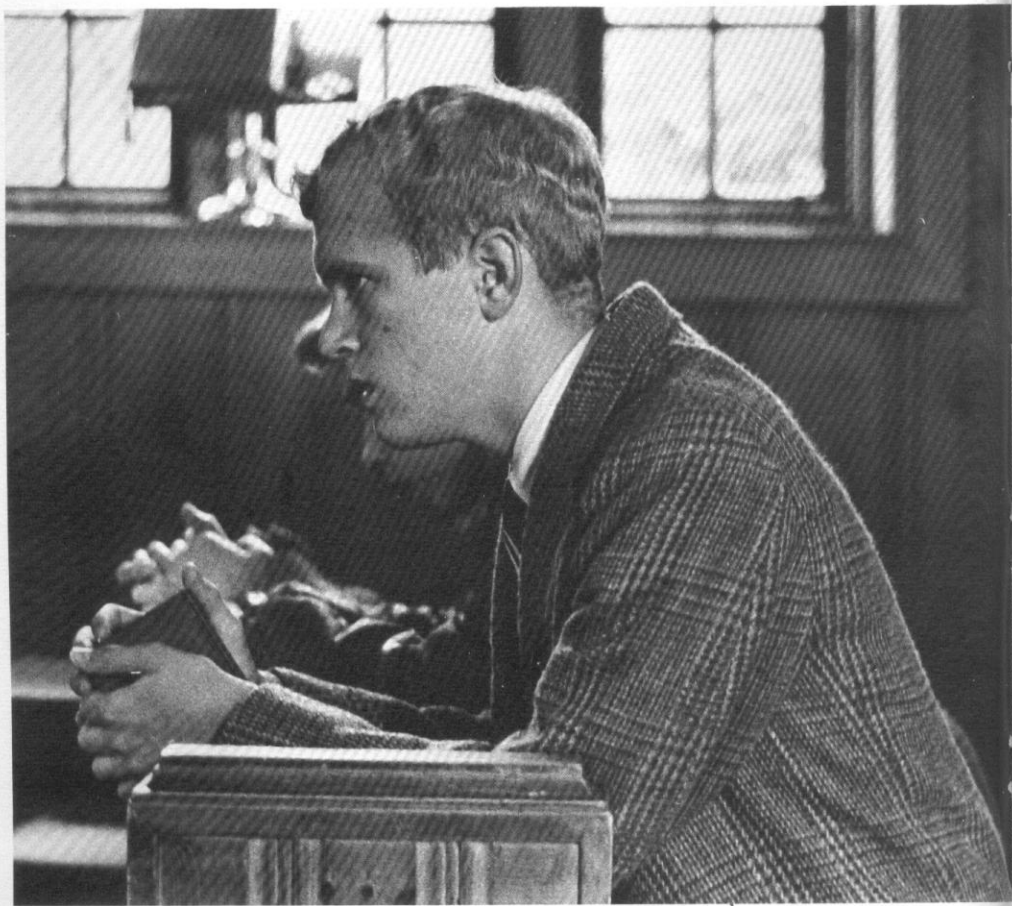
Student Government Leads

Religion Is the Center



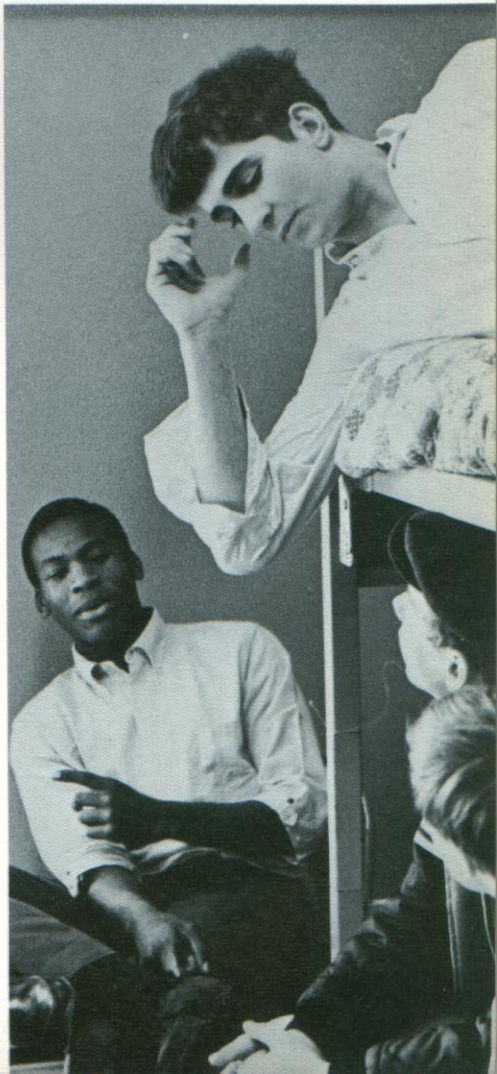


The chapel is to St. Peter's as the sun is to the solar system. It is the base and center of the school around which everything revolves.
