A student develops the ability to be discriminatory, judging his peers as well as those from whom he learns.


One learns to distinguish among the variables in life while maintaining a standard of integrity.

The result of this complicated process is the senior, who possesses a foundation of knowledge needed to meet the challenge of higher education and life.








A senior is the result






Enthusiasm is often kindled
