## TRIVIA GAME IDEAS

- **Four Corners** Number your trivia answers 1, 2, 3, 4, and have kids move to the corner with the correct answer.
- **This or That** Kids stand in the middle of the room and have to move to one side or the other (right or left), whichever has the correct answer.
- **Team Face Off** Divide into teams and have them face off using a buzzer. The first to hit the buzzer gets a chance to answer.
- **Screen Games** Though not interactive, putting the trivia games on screen engages visual learners better.
- **Beanbag Toss** Make yes/no bins that children have to toss a beanbag or ball into to answer the question.
- **True/False Answer Signs** Print out true/false (or yes/no) paper signs and give one to each child. Have them hold up the correct answer.
- **Pick a Question** Write or print questions on slips of paper and place them in a bin filled with crinkle paper, ballers, or some sort of filler. Select volunteers to dig for the question and allow them or the whole group to answer. (This one is great for engaging littles! They feel they are participating without having to know the answer.)
