TEACHING TOOL FAVORITES

- **Timeline Poster** aids in helping children understand the Biblical narrative and where we are in God's story.
- **Yes/No Signs** turns the introduction into a full-body game rather than a lecture.
- **Gift Box** (with removable lid) illustrates the gift of grace or any time gifts are mentioned.
- Numbered Buckets (1-5) hide objects in or under buckets to either teach lesson points or hide treats for review answers.
- **Costume Pieces** plastic chains, robes, shepherd staff, crown, and more all aid in acting out the Bible account.
- Magnifying Glasses use them to make a lesson scavenger hunt more fun or to investigate deeper in the Bible.
- **Theology Word Wall** print out big theological terms you use and put them on the wall. Every time you use them, refer to the wall.
- **Blue Fabric** (sheet or photo backdrop) this can be a prop for acting out stories with water, a backdrop for decor, or it can cover the day's teaching props to build excitement.
