BEHIND THE COVER (LITERALLY)

"Amata" translates to "beloved" and "doods" translates as "death".

To me, making art as Amata Doods is all about falling in love with the process of ego death and not letting your conscious mind take full control during the creation process.

When I construct a piece, it's a contemplation about what the Most High considers when forming life. Creation starts with a cell, forms tissues, tissues become organs, and eventually we see conscious beings.



My creation process focuses on the formation of figures in the same way. My work questions whether consciousness and creatures' final forms were the aim, or simply a beautiful byproduct of the construction process. Focusing on the patterns that build life, and not the final product, allows me to create something unique and bring these invisible building blocks to the foreground of every piece. The freeform process allows me to focus more on earnestly depicting energy than demanding perfection.

While I have no formal art education, I cemented my love of repetitive linework while working with Native American art as an archaeologist. There is also intentional incorporation of Sufism into the spirit of the work I do through repetition, use of complementary contraries, and the transcendence of differing energies into one unified figure. "Doods" are minimalism, complexity, and surrealism. They are childish, have deep meaning and intention, and are open to interpretation like clouds. They are poetry and also just a bunch of fucking shapes. It's all true.

In the past couple of years I've had the opportunity to focus on expanding my marker work into printmaking, Arabic calligraphy, brush drawing, and painting. I am blessed to be able to work out of Screwed Arts Collective and it has opened up a whole new world for me.

I've finally been able to expand my events work and now have a monthly free-drawing meet up called Go With The Flow that incorporates judgement-free improvisational drawing and live beats for folks from all parts of the creative spectrum. I've done this work with all ages, but I'm very excited that some of the work I did with kids on the Northside this summer is currently on view at the Contemporary Art Museum as a part of the CAM Connect Showcase.

You can catch my work at Artica in October, the Cherokee Print Bazaar in December, or anytime at Virtuoso Collective on Cherokee.

Pumpkin Eurry

(because it's Fall, get it?)

Main Ingredients

4-5 medium carrots (diced)
2 medium red, orange, or yellow bell
peppers (diced)
1 medium onion (diced)
1 inch hunk of ginger (grated or pastified)
3-4 garlic cloves (minced or pastified)
1 15 ounce can of pumpkin puree
1 15 ounce can chickpeas
½ 15 ounce can of coconut milk
3-4 tablespoons cooking oil
(I recommend avocado)


Spice Blend Ingredients

2 tablespoons curry powder
1 tablespoon cumin
1 tablespoon coriander
1 tablespoon mustard seeds
1 tablespoon salt
1 teaspoon cinnamon
1 teaspoon black pepper
½ teaspoon cardamon
½ teaspoon cloves

Instructions

Heat the oil over medium/medium-low heat in a big pot. Add the onions and all of the spices and stir it up. Add more oil if it's sticking. Cook the onions for five minutes or so, and then add the ginger and garlic. Cook for another minute or two. Add the rest of the veggies plus chickpeas and coat them all in the onion/spice goodness. Cook them for a couple of more minutes and then add the pumpkin. Stir that up, cook for a minute, and then add the coconut milk. Once it's mixed and turning a lovely pale orange color, cover and simmer over low heat for 30-40 minutes until veggies are softened and your kitchen smells awesome.

The Cardinals Top Two MVPs of the 2025 Season

Thanks for sticking around. This Cardinals season has been, yet again, kind of a bummer. But that doesn't mean we can't celebrate the fun stuff! Because a beloved baseball team—even one that ends the season hovering around .500—still played baseball. If you're a smart person with a romantic soul for the game, you can appreciate the positive aspects of the 2025 Cardinals.

Last November I recapped my top three MVPs for the 2024 Cardinals. Please go read my article at www.thebrockstreetburner.com! This year's record was about the same amount of disappointment as last year's, yet finding the top three best players was a little trickier. I suppose mediocrity was spread throughout this team more evenly. Due to that, plus space constraints, I present to you my top two 2025 St. Louis Cardinals MVPs.



#1 Masyn Winn

Honestly, this was a no brainer. "But this dude only has a .253 batting average, 9 HRs, 51 RBIs and a .673 OPS," you might be saying. ".721 OPS is league average. 48 points below isn't even good," you might also be saying. Fine. His offensive stats aren't as good as they could be. And that's okay. He's 23, which is two years younger than Aaron Judge when he even made his rookie debut. Shohei Ohtani was 24 his rookie year. Next year will be Winn's third full season in the big leagues at 24 years old, so let's give his offense a little grace. Cool?

Despite his mediocre—or slightly below—offense, Masyn Winn was my no-brainer pick for this year's #1 Cardinals MVP, because of his defense at a premium position: shortstop. He currently leads all of the National League with 22 Outs Above Average (at all defensive positions; not just shortstop). And he's four above the next guy.

Outs Above Average basically means that he's made 22 more outs at his position than the average MLB player is expected to make. A completely average shortstop has 0 Outs Above Average. 22 better than the average player? Not too shabby.

In 2025, as of today, September 14th, Winn is third in the National League in the Fielding Run Value statistic. That's similar to Outs Above Average, except it's the number of runs the player has saved above the average player, directly due to their defensive plays. Winn's Fielding Run Value is 17. Think about one defensive player saving 17 runs for the team in roughly 130 games. That's very valuable!

The last fun stat that makes my case for how important Winn's defense is to this team's success (be it limited, but he tried) is his .994 fielding percentage leading all shortstops in the MLB. That's a simple one; it just means that he made 99.4% of plays where he had the opportunity, without messing it up.

If those don't convince you, I'm not sure what will.



#2 Kyle Leahy



"Who the bleep is Kyle Leahy?" The average baseball fan might be asking. He's not a flashy dude. He's one of those players that walks up to the mound and gives off a "I guess I can give this pitching thing a try" demeanor. But he's been so important for this team.

Kyle Leahy leads this year's Cardinals relief pitchers with 80 innings pitched as of September 14th. That's 25 more innings than the next guy. There has been a bit of minor league to major league turnover as well as three big relief pitcher trades. That shows even further how important Leahy's consistency & durability has been.

And he hasn't only pitched twice as many innings as most of the other relief pitchers; he's also pretty good at it. He currently has a 2.93 ERA, which is good for 46th (out of 153) amongst other relief pitchers with at least 50 innings pitched this year. So, Leahy won't be making MLB TV big stories of the day very often. But he's been very solidly and quietly keeping this bullpen afloat for the entirety of the 2025 season.

Next up for Cardinals fans is waiting out the long, cold months of the off season until next March. And hopefully by next September I will have more of a plethora of choices for MVP candidates. Hopefully even some playoff baseball in St. Louis to talk about again?







What happens when you are the product instead of the consumer? Well, wonder no more, my friend, for that's the world we already live in. Last time we talked about an easy change you can make to benefit your life in 2025, this one, however, is one you might find difficult, but I highly believe it's worth it. And I think some of you might too. Let's talk about how you can ditch the all-seeing eye of Google--really.

First, for those of you who may not already know, let's talk about **why** you might want to get this digital service we've been sold as an "integral" part of every day life nowadays. While, Google started as a very useful company that helped us find the things we were looking for around the web, it has grown an insane amount since then. But what happened? Well, the short version is, that we found it so useful that nearly all of us had an account.

once and get too overwhelmed to consider trying at all. Start small, don't rush, and if you're like me, research! Make small goals to get everything moved over. Without a Pixel, you completely lose the opportunity to run **GrapheneOS**, which is only available on Google and much loved—and my personal choice. However, I almost chose **e/OS** or **Lineage OS** instead because the phone I want most is a Fairphone! But alas, I just didn't want to drop so many hundreds on it. Before I finally landed on my refurbished non-flashy Google Pixel, I actually purchased a refurbished OnePlus 9 because they have FANTASTIC cameras. But I learned too late that it was an incompatible model number.

Instead of fighting what looked like an uphill battle I promptly returned it and decided to go for a Pixel so I could have my pick of OS.

The next thing to note is what apps are most important to you and which ones you need constant access to and which you definitely shouldn't--I'm looking at you, amazon. For those of us that wax poetic about the days when phones were easier to forget about entirely, you might be fine not having only the ones that come with your OS.

If that's not enough for you, you're not alone. You can download F-Droid for indie apps and Aurora Store to access most of the ones you're used to on Google Play. There's one caveat, of course. Some of these apps will require Google Play Services. Some will work just fine without. But if your favorite one just won't download or run without it, you may have to give up a sliver of that newfound privacy.

In a world where there's talk of prosecuting thought crimes, peaceful protest is no longer protected, and the government is compiling our sensitive data with private companies who mine for it... it's time to salvage all the privacy we still can. I could've gone on about this for so many more pages, but at the very least, I wanted to point you in the right direction, because unfortunately, this is hardly a simple topic.


