



Dogs on Site Policy

Proof of up-to-date vaccinations (including boosters) is required at the time of booking. Initial vaccinations must be completed at least 21 days before arrival, and annual vaccinations at least 72 hours before arrival. Dogs must also be free from contagious illnesses and parasites (fleas, ticks, worms), and any dog showing signs of illness may be refused entry or asked to leave.

Dogs must be at least six (6) months old and fully vaccinated before being allowed on site.

All dogs must be non-aggressive, well-behaved, and under the owner's control at all times. Management reserves the right to require any dog to be leashed or removed from the site if its behaviour is deemed disruptive, aggressive, or unsafe towards people, other dogs, wildlife, or property.

Dogs must be house-trained. Any accidents inside tents or on terraces must be reported immediately to Management so appropriate cleaning and sanitisation can be arranged.

Dogs should be fed inside tents or in a controlled space to avoid attracting wildlife or causing conflict between dogs.

All dog waste must be picked up and disposed of in the appropriate bin (located by the private washrooms).

The farm is fully fenced, however, Naseem Chalets and Camps (SPS LLC) bears no responsibility for any dogs that manage to go beyond the boundary. Owners must ensure gates and access points are closed after use.

Dogs must be supervised at all times. Management reserves the right to require dogs to be leashed if deemed necessary for safety or guest comfort.

Owners remain responsible for any property damage, additional cleaning, or injury caused by their dog, and charges may be applied to the booking card without further notice.

Banned breeds are not permitted on site.

Digging, damaging plants, or interfering with irrigation systems is strictly prohibited.

Female dogs on heat are not permitted on the farm.

Owners should be mindful that toys, food and treats may cause disputes between dogs. Management is not responsible for any incidents arising from such items.

Owners must ensure their dogs do not chase, harass, or harm wildlife. Please be cautious of local wildlife, which may pose risks to your dog.

To the maximum extent permitted under UAE law, Naseem Chalets and Camps (SPS LLC) accepts no responsibility for the illness, injury, loss, or death of any pet, nor for injury or damage caused by a pet whilst on site.
