Questions for Discussion & Reflection

Judges 6 - 7

1. How does Judges 6:1-6 demonstrate the consequences of sin?
2. Who were the Midianites? Why were they so successful?
3. Read 2 Corinthians 7:10 and compare it to Judges 6:6. Were the Israelites truly repenting?
4. When we are introduced to Gideon, what kind of man was he? Yet how does God address him?
5. What kind of person are you? Do you tend to define yourself by your sin? By your vocation? By your family/nation? By your ministry? How does God see you? (Hint: check out Ephesians 1)
6. It is likely that the angel who appears in this chapter is a "theophany" – a pre-incarnate appearance of Christ Himself. What evidence is there for this view? Can you think of other examples where the angel of the Lord appears?
7. What disadvantages did Gideon face (at least according to traditional military wisdom)?
8. Gideon's faith falters and he puts out a fleece. Is this a practice we should imitate? Why or why not?
9. How does God demonstrate compassion and mercy in his dealings with Gideon?
10. Why might God's plan have been so terrifying to the Midianites?
11. God is always who He says He is and does what He says He will do. Where is your faith?
