Questions for Discussion & Reflection

Judges 10 - 12

1. What has changed between Judges 2:11 and 10:6? What does this demonstrate about idolatry and its progression?
2. When we face trouble in our lives or have sin revealed – do we really repent? Or do we just try to avoid the consequences?
3. Which God you serve matters. How do the Israelites reap the consequences of this in Judges 10:6-9?
4. What is Jephthah's "resume" (C.V.)? Since God chose Jephthah anyway – what do we learn about God (I Corinthians 1:26-31)?
5. How does Jephthah demonstrate faith throughout these chapters?
6. Compare & contrast the Israelites' relations with God and Jephthah.
7. Despite being rejected by his family and clan, Jephthah does not recoil from God, or even refuse to return to fellowship with his family. When we have been rejected or hurt by God's people, how can we imitate Jephthah?
8. How does the King of Ammon try to replace history with propaganda? How does Jephthah respond to the King of Ammon? Why is it important for us to know history?
9. How does Jephthah's story overshadow his faith in God (especially his vow at the end of chapter 11)?
