The Missouri Farm Bill Biologists (FBB) are partnership positions supported by the Natural Resources Conservation Service and the Missouri Department of Conservation. Cain will work with private landowners in the southeast portion of the state, helping them with wildlife and habitat management planning and securing funds to implement those plans.

Cain has spent time as a Technician with the Missouri Department of Conservation, Crew Lead for over-water nesting waterfowl research in Manitoba, Canada for Delta Waterfowl Foundation, and as a Statewide Wetland Program Biologist for the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. In her spare time, she enjoys hunting, fishing, waterfowl taxidermy, and gardening.
