**RICHMOND, Mo. – March 30, 2022** – Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever in Missouri is excited to share that Logan Baum was hired for the Richmond, Mo., Farm Bill Wildlife Biologist II position. He started his new position March 7.

The Farm Bill Wildlife Biologists on the Missouri team are partnership positions supported by the Natural Resources Conservation Service, the Missouri Dept. of Conservation, and the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation. Baum will work with private landowners in Clinton, Caldwell, and Ray counties helping them with wildlife management planning and securing funds to help implement those plans.

"Logan has an extensive background of working with private landowners and working with various conservation programs on both private and public lands," said Missouri State Coordinator, Andrew White. "He brings a wealth of knowledge to the position, and we're excited to have him working to improve habitat for quail and other wildlife in northwest Missouri."



Baum grew up on a cattle ranch in southeast Nebraska. He graduated from Northwest Missouri State University with a B.S in Wildlife Ecology and Conservation. Since he was a child, Baum has been an avid hunter and outdoorsman. His degree and professional experience combined with his personal experiences helped him seize an opportunity to work on a whitetail game ranch in Texas. Baum also spent time working for Soil and Water Conservation as well as NRCS in Missouri before joining Pheasants Forever & Quail Forever to serve as a Farm Bill Wildlife Biologist.
