

SEDALIA, Mo. - September 16, 2020 - Quail Forever continues to expand its presence in Missouri with the creation of its 24th chapter on Aug. 26. The Central Missouri Chapter of Quail Forever is the state's third new chapter to sign a charter since May.

It was the second meeting held to launch this chapter; the first was held virtually and laid the groundwork. Two weeks later, chapter members and Quail Forever staff met in person to solidify the chapter's foundation, a key component for success.

"Our goal is to ensure the next generation understands that conservation, farming and the outdoor lifestyle go hand in hand to guarantee a future of successful wildlife habitat for decades to come," said newly elected Chapter President Joseph White.

The chapter's mission is the conservation of quail, pheasants and other wildlife through habitat improvements, public awareness, education, and land management policies and programs.



Trevor Day, Regional Representative for northern Missouri and eastern Kansas, hosted both meetings and was thrilled with the enthusiasm he saw.

"This chapter is excited to get up and running," Day said. "But it also showed great patience in making sure it wasn't rushed and the proper people were on board to get it off on the right foot. It has a bright future ahead."
