Dental Program Updates

ACT 55 Information

The mandated dental program previously required the completion of dental examinations by a dentist licensed within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Act 55 was signed into law December 2023, and amended the language of school based "dental examinations" to "dental screenings," and enables public health dental hygiene practitioners (PHDHP) to complete the mandated dental screenings.

ACT 122 – VISION SCREENING

Senate Bill 700 amends the language in Act 122 and was signed into law as a part of Act 55 on July 11, 2024.

This language now allows the Department of Health to promulgate vision screening regulations.

Updated vision screening standards are currently in the process of stakeholder review. The next step will place the proposed standards on the regulatory agenda: PA Code and Bulletin

New vision screening guidelines will go into effect after the regulations are promulgated. There is no definitive timeframe. School Health will send out

more information when available.

Continuous Glucose Monitoring



If a student with diabetes uses a CGM for their glucose monitoring, the school nurse and/or trained non-clinical school staff are expected to use the CGM in accordance with the student's DMMP/504 and provider orders (frequency of monitoring etc.)

The decision to remotely monitor a student's CGM is <u>individualized</u> and based upon the unique needs of each student.

The Division of School Health recommends the development of a 504/DMMP for students using a CGM in the school setting.
